**RESOLUTION HONORING THE LIFE OF THE HONORABLE HAROLD  
ROGER JONES**

WHEREAS, Harold Roger Jones was born in Oakland, California, on October 15, 1947, and was the eldest son of Charles Roger Jones and Sachie Yamauchi Jones;

WHEREAS, Mr. Jones graduated from Kalani High School in 1965 and immediately enlisted in the United States Navy, where he served his country in the Vietnam War;

WHEREAS, Mr. Jones graduated from the University of Hawaii with high honors in 1970, and while attending the University, started a local chapter of Campus Crusade for Christ with his beloved wife, Lana;

WHEREAS, Mr. Jones served as a member of the Hawaii State House of Representatives from 1982 until 1988, and was awarded Outstanding State Legislator of the Year in 1986 by the American Legislative Exchange Council;

WHEREAS, Mr. Jones served the Republican National Committee (RNC) as Hawaii's National Committeeman from 1988 to 1992;

WHEREAS, Mr. Jones was the owner and principal broker of ERA Jones Realty, which eventually merged with Coldwell Banker Pacific Properties;

WHEREAS, After retiring from real estate, Mr. Jones was the president and chief executive officer for Global Hope Network International, which he co-founded with his wife and with the blessing of Bill Bright of Campus Crusade for Christ in 2001;

WHEREAS, Mr. Jones was passionate about alleviating poverty in the world and holistically taught the poor in five key sectors - food security, water security, wellness, education, and income generation using the Transformational Community Development curriculum, which is currently taught in over 50 countries around the world;

WHEREAS, Mr. Jones founded the Geneva Institute for Leadership and Public Policy in 2010 in Geneva, Switzerland, to help aspiring leaders in developing countries write and implement successful public policy; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Jones passed away on October 27, 2020 at the Hilo Memorial Medical Center, and is survived by his beloved wife, Lana; children, Adam (Alyson) Jones of Florida, Kehaulani (Todd) Uyeda of Florida, Aaron (Maris) Jones of Hawaii, and Noelani (Benjamin) Sturzenegger of MuttENZ, Switzerland; brother, Dr. Lloyd (Janet) Jones of Hawaii; fourteen grandchildren and numerous nieces and nephews; therefore, be it
